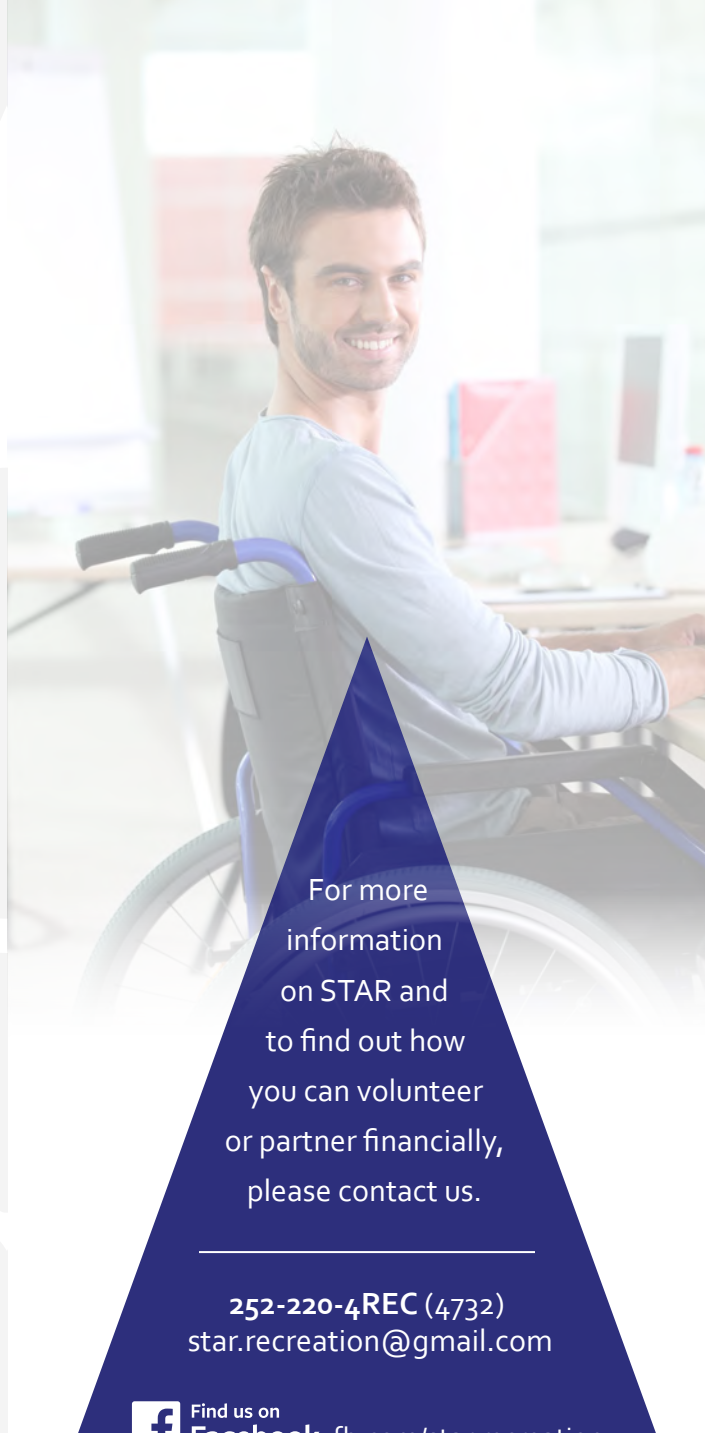

This event focuses on a specific activity that can be modified and adapted so that individuals with disabilities can play specific sports. Previous adapted sports have included wheelchair rugby, power wheelchair hockey, adapted sled ice hockey and adapted golf.
